2013 Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity Hills, Seven Springs Vineyard – 92 points

\$55/bottle \$110/magnum

Crisp and tangy, with a mineral character running through the raspberry and cherry flavors at the core, coming together with harmony and structural tension on the vibrant finish. Best from 2017 through 2023. 3,054 cases made. –*HS*

2013 Pinot Noir, Eola-Amity Hills, Seven Springs Vineyard, La Source – 93 points

\$75/bottle \$150/magnum

Fresh and inviting, open-textured and appealing, with cherry, floral and mineral flavors gliding smoothly into a harmonious finish. Has terrific presence, depth and persistence. Drink now through 2021. 850 cases made. –*HS*

2013 Chardonnay, Eola-Amity Hills, Seven Springs Vineyard – 91 points

\$45/bottle

Fresh and inviting, lively on balance, with tangy citrus and lemon marmalade notes underlying the apple and spice flavors, lingering on the finish. Drink now through 2020. 607 cases made. -HS

2013 Chardonnay, Eola-Amity Hills, Seven Springs Vineyard, *La Source* – 94 points \$70/bottle \$140/magnum

Taut, focused, complex and immediately inviting, deftly layering pear, nectarine, citrus, loamy earth and floral aromas and flavors as the finish plays on. Shows good tension between the fruit and savory notes. Drink now through 2023. 390 cases made. –*HS*

2013 Chardonnay, Eola-Amity Hills, Seven Springs Vineyard, *Summum* – 95 points \$90/bottle \$180/magnum

Taut, focused and juicy, with lemon, lemon verbena and mineral overtones to the lithe, lively, open-textured pear and apple flavors, lingering expressively as the finish floats on. Drink now through 2023. 288 cases made. –*HS*
