**2006 Podere Ruggeri Corsini Barbera d'Alba Superiore "Armujan" \$26.**

Single Vineyard, Old Vine Barbera. This wine is amazing...I could smell this wine all night long it is truly beautiful and I can't wait for you to taste!

**2004 Podere Ruggeri Corsini Barolo \$44.50**

Gorgeous aromas of blackberry, raspberry and strawberry. Full-bodied, with a wonderful core of ripe yet fresh fruit. Long and silky. Ultrarefined. Best after 2011. 450 cases made. **Suggested retail \$60.** - 91 Points Wine Spectator

**2004 Fontanabianca Barbaresco "Sori Burdin" \$63.**

Pola's 2004 Barbaresco Sori Burdin has turned out beautifully. It is a big, authoritative Barbaresco loaded with super-ripe red fruit, macerated cherries, menthol, minerals, flowers and spices. Endowed with notable weight and a layered texture, it offers outstanding concentration and fine, well-integrated tannins. This is a terrific effort from Fontanabianca.
