This opaque purple-colored beauty offers terrific black currant and cassislike fruit intermixed with classic tobacco leaf, damp earth, and crushed flower aromas and flavors. Rich, fullbodied, and elegant, with a seamless texture that carries plenty of sweet tannins, give bottles 2-4 years in the cellar and it's going to keep for another 15-20 years. 2015 Dunham Cabernet Sauvignon XXI \$45 Coming from 100% Cabernet and aged 18 months in 50% new French oak, the 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon XXI offers terrific crème de cassis, toasted spiced, dried flowers, and hints of cedar box. Elegant, medium to full-bodied, and balanced, it shines for its purity and elegance as well as its texture. Drink it over the coming 10-12 years or more. **92+ Points Wine Advocate**

N.V. Manos Walla Walla Cabernet Sauvignon \$60

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Beautiful Snowflake bottling perfect Christmas gift for family, friend or coworker. Impenetrably dark. An explosive nose of coffee, red and black fruits, Russian sage and garden herbs. Lesser notes follow of crème cassis, currant and black olive. On the palate, the same wine is dense, sweet and broodingly dark. Simply perfect fine-grained tannin melded with laser-focused acidity deliver impressive length that linger on the palate. 2017 Luke Cabernet Sauvignon \$20 LUKE Cabernet Sauvignon offers aromas dominated by Marionberry and dark chocolate, accented by hints of mint and molasses. On the palate the wine is supple, focused and expressive, layering coffee accented blackberry and currant flavors with polished tannins and hints of cedar and smoke.
