### 2012 Sleight Hand Archimage Red Blend \$54

The best vintage for this cuvee to date, there are 775 cases of the 2012 The Archimage (49% Cabernet Franc, 48% Merlot and the rest Cabernet Sauvignon). It offers classic blackcurrants, graphite, leafy herbs and hints of charred meats to go with a full-bodied, supple, layered and beautifully pure profile on the palate. Seeing 20 months in 39% new French oak, it has enough mid-palate depth and fine tannin on the finish to evolve for 10-15 years. **93 Points Robert Parker** 

Trey Busch continues to shows his wine making talent with these latest releases, and I was impressed with the entire lineup. Don't let the whimsical names fool you, these are top-notch wines. In addition, there's some killer value here as well.

#### 2010 Kennedy Shaw Cabernet Franc \$45

Aromatic with flowers Licorice, earth, caramel and ripe sweet blackberry. On the palate the wine is fresh, deep, straightforward and long in the finish.
