THE WINES:

2010 Rombauer Carneros Chardonnay \$37.50

Golden yellow color with a pale hue. Seductive aromas of peach, melon, and citrus are balanced with honeysuckle and vanilla. On the palate, flavors of pears, peaches and melons are backed with lively acidity. A nice touch of vanilla-scented oak provides an added flavor dimension. The creamy palate has a lingering finish of melon and citrus fruit with a satisfying buttery complexity. Our favorite pairing for this wine includes scallops in a cream sauce, pasta carbonara, chicken risotto and Cornish game hen.

2007 Domaine Du Pesquier Gigondas \$33

Another beauty from what is certainly the finest Gigondas vintage I have ever tasted, this 2007 boasts a deep ruby/purple color along with endearing notes of black and red currants, raspberries, and crushed rocks. The tannins are sweet and mature, and the wine is deep, full-bodied, and impressively layered and long. It will be even better with 1-2 years of bottle age, and should keep for 10-12 years **91+ Robert Parker**

2008 Abeja Cabernet Sauvignon Walla Walla \$42. If you have never experienced this wine...here is your chance...take it!

What I really like is how this wine combines the bright red and blue fruit and lingering mouth feel of Washington State Cabernet Sauvignon with the nice, old-world Bordeaux characters of saddle leather, cedar, and tar. The nose is fruitful and forward upon opening the bottle. Dense, dark, fruit characters – plums, boysenberries, and blackberries – are woven with a slight suggestion of soy. The mouth is rich and finishes with fine-grained, polished tannins. The 2008 Columbia Valley is also the first Cabernet Sauvignon we have released with a bit of Petit Verdot in the blend, which really drives the fruit and structure in the wine. John Abbot Wine Maker

2008 Alejandro Fernandez Tinto Pasquera Spain \$35.

The dark ruby-colored 2008 Tinto Pasquera exhibits an inviting nose of cedar, spice box, mineral, violets, and blackberry. This is followed by a ripe, racy, nicely proportioned style of Tempranillo with excellent concentration and length. Give it 2-3 years to fully blossom **91 Points Robert Parker**

2010 The Prisoner Napa Valley Red Wine \$37.50 Always the favorite!

Dark red, almost garnet hue with bright red on the rim. Ripe cherry and cedar on the nose with hints of dried rose petal and sweet oak. Lovely entry that leads into a fat and savory mid palate. Ripe fig and black currant dominate the finish with a breadth of soft, well integrated tannins.— Dave Phinney, Winemaker. 44% Zinfandel 26% Cabernet Sauvignon 18% Syrah 9% Petite Sirah 2% Charbono 1% Grenache

2009 Bosquet Des Papes Chateauneuf Du Papes \$50

75% Grenache with Mourvedre, Syrah, Vaccaresse, Counoise, Cinsault. De-stemmed, aged in large barrel, 550 liter casks and vat.) The "regular" cuvee from Bosquet des Papes is a consistently great value in a traditional style, and soft enough to drink young. "Quite dark, bright and full red. Welcoming, shapely red fruit aroma - immediate appeal, comes with a little smokiness, ash. Really good palate, tasty start, runs with a consistent flow, strawberry jam in the flavor. Fresh and clear at the end, very faithful to it's place a wine of terroir, good balance. Drink from spring 2012 to 2023-2025." **93 pts Robert Parker**
