NV Jaillance Cremant de Bordeaux Cuvee de Abbaye Brut \$15.

NV Duval Leroy Paris Label \$36.

This is the last year for this beautiful Champagne and package!

"Rich and biscuity, with a fine mousse and a firm beam of acidity for support. This sets the stage for the peach, vanilla and warm spice notes. There's lovely harmony and finesse, with a lingering finish". 91 Points Wine Spectator!

NV Deutz Brut Classic \$46.

"70% pinot noir, 27% chardonnay and 3% pinot meunier, almost all from grand cru villages; Disgorged 04/22/09. Bright gold with pinpoint bubbles. Peach skin, nectarine and orange on the nose, with hints of smoke and dried flowers adding complexity. Deep but lively, offering a suave combination of pit and citrus fruit flavors and good back-end cut. Picks up an exotic note of candied flowers that lingers on the juicy, well-delineated finish." **91 Points Stephen Tanzer**

1999 Argyle Extended Triage Oregon \$60 (limited amount available)

NV Louis Roederer Brut Premier \$43.
