2014 Woodward Canyon Old Vine Cabernet Sauvignon Walla Walla \$112

The 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Old Vines is a deep, rich and beautifully textured effort that gives up tons of chocolate, dark fruit, licorice, roasted herbs and hints of spice. It's a ripe, broad, textured and concentrated effort that has tons to love. It's my favorite in this stacked lineup. The blend here is 96% Cabernet Sauvignon and 4% Petit Verdot, and it's going to have 2-3 decades of life. **94 Points Wine Advocate**

2015 Scattered Peaks Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley \$46

Roasted herb, coffee, black cherry and blackberry fruit compote on the nose. The palate is rich and concentrated but never heavy, with a lively acidity providing a sense of movement. Tannins are mighty and show that this will blossom with more time. **97 Points Decanter**

2015 Pepper Bridge Cabernet Walla Walla \$58

"Bright violet-ruby color. Aromas of kirsch, blackberry, violet and spicy oak, complicated by a whiff of tobacco leaf. Plush, tactile and fine-grained, showing noteworthy energy and spice character to its flavors of cassis, blackberry, licorice, cocoa powder and violet. - 91 Points Stephen Tanzer"

2011 Henry Earl Homesteader Cabernet Sauvignon \$42

Bdx style wine of CS, CF and Malbec. 80% new French oak (!) Subtle, dusky nose of black cassis/cassis, blackberries, tobacco and green herbs. Similar flavors on the palate, good acidity and tannin. The oak has, thanks to time, mellowed a little – this wine would have been a beast when young! Now it is amazing!

2016 Brook & Bull Walla Walla Cabernet Sauvignon \$36

This wine's near-equal parts Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec saw just a touch (15%) of new oak. The aromas draw you into the glass, evoking plums, cloves, dried herbs and spices. Its ripe, full, soft fruit flavors coat the palate, extending into a warm finish. It exudes a lovely sense of purity. 91 Points Wine Enthusiast

2016 Daniel Cohn Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma County \$26

With aromas like wood smoke, cardamom and black pepper, this is a beefy, spicy wine. It is full bodied, quite oaky in flavor, and almost tastes like pepper steak in liquid form. Ripe and satisfying dark-fruit flavors kick in and linger on the finish. 89 Points Wine Enthusiast

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
