The Wines:

2009 Cougar Crest Dedication Six \$20.50

Focused, polished and rich in flavor, deftly balancing flavors of black cherry and black currant, with shades of mint and sage accenting the generous, but not weighty, package. Shows depth and length. Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc and Malbec. Drink now through 2017

2009 Gilbert Cellars "Alloborges" \$20

Refreshing, with tight tannins around a core of fresh berry and toast. Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and Counoise. Drink now through 2014.

2009 Fall Line "Exhibition Red" \$22

Combining fruit from all of their otherwise featured vineyard sources, and 5% Tempranillo with roughly equal parts of the three main Bordelais cepages, Fall Line's 2009 Exhibition smells of cassis, sealing wax, and nut oils. Juicy and persistent, its bitter aspects enhanced by an impression of huckleberry, this fine value and ideal introduction to the winery's house style ought to prove versatile over the next several years.

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2010 Buty "The Beast" Wildebeest Columbia Valley \$20.50

We tracked Wildebeest into the heart of the vines, enamored by his sleek form, and plucked him from the field. Wildebeest is an over-delivering wine from Phinny Hill Vineyard's best vintage yet. Its dark purple color is a sign of its oncoming power. The impressive and driving vineyard character of Phinny Hill comes through in this energetic blend of cabernet sauvignon, syrah and malbec. Prized for tremendous substance, Wildebeest is a stunning catch.

2008 Patit Creek Merlot Walla Walla \$30

The 2008 Merlot displays a pleasing perfume of smoke, Asian spices, violets, cassis, and black currant. This leads to a supple, round, full-flavored Merlot that will blossom for several more years. Drink this fleshy effort from 2013 to 2023. **90 Robert Parker**

2008 Cougar Crest Cabernet Sauvignon \$38

Broad, supple, generous and expressive, this offers a plush mouthful of gravelly blackberry, plum, chocolate and spice flavors that glide easily through the long finish. Best from 2014 through 2020. 1,060 cases made. *-HS 93 Points wine Spectator*
