2013 The Pines Pinot Gris \$17

Selected by the Oregon Wine Press as "Best Value Pick: Pinot Gris." This crisp Pinot Gris fills your nose with aromas of pineapple and meyer lemon while green apple, honeysuckle, and pineapple linger on your palate. This wine pairs well with seafood, thai, chicken, and pork.

2013 The Pines Big Red \$18

This wine brings together the best of four wines for a hearty blend of 40% Merlot, 30% Syrah, 20% Zin, and 10% Cab. Sauv. The Big Red is deep garnet in color and entices your nose with aromas of blackberry and cigar box. This fruit-forward blend fills your mouth with flavors of raspberry, cassis, with a white pepper finish. Enjoy with pasta or anything grilled.

2012 The Pines Merlot \$24.50
