The Incognito Rouge was produced to create another enticing mystery for the consumer. Our Rouge blend changes every vintage using very mysterious Rhone style varietals. Syrah, Mourvedre and Carignane are regulars to the bottle's enticement, but really, the only thing you can be sure of is that the contents will please your palate. 2006 Incognito Rouge is a tango of Mourvedre, Syrah, Petite Sirah, Cinsault, Carignane, Tannat, Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Grenache. What no Zin? I could have sworn this wine was zin based...oh well, you will love it. We Did!!!!

2008 Four Vines "The Sophisticate" Zinfandel, Sonoma County \$25.

Our 2008 Sonoma Zin is from the beautiful Somers Vineyard in Dry Creek Valley and the 85-year old Old Crow Vineyard in Russian River Valley. The wine was kissed with a touch of Petite Sirah and aged in small French and American oak barrels for 14 months. The result is a well-dressed, ruckus country brawler of surprising style and grace. Nicknamed "The Sophisticate‰ because it expresses the elegant side of Zinfandel, this wine has a sexy nose with velvet vanilla oak tones, followed by rich, spicy berry fruit and a hint of cedar. Big flavors, yet refined and stylish. The James Bond of Zinfandel∑he will seduce you.

2008 Orin Swift "The Prisonier" \$37.50

Focused, rich and ripe, showing aromas of black cherry and smoky pepper, with sleek but complex flavors of boysenberry, licorice and toasty oak that linger with balanced tannins. Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Petite Sirah, Charbono and Grenache. Drink now through 2015. **92 Points Wine Spectator**

2005 Marietta Angeli Cuvee Geyeserville CA. \$29

The top wine is the brilliant 2005 Angeli Cuvee, a Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, and Carignan blend crafted by proprietor/winemaker Chris Bilbro. One of the finest examples of this wine he has yet made, the 2005 boasts a dense purple color as well as plump, succulent, sumptuous blue, red, and black fruits intermixed with notions of wood spice, earth, and pepper. The wine cuts a full-bodied, fleshy, multidimensional swath across the palate, and the finish lasts over 40 seconds. Very drinkable already, it should evolve effortlessly for another 7-8+ years. **93 Points Robert Parker**

2007 Ridge Geyserville Proprietary Red Blend \$36.

The dark ruby/purple-colored 2007 Geyserville Proprietary Red (58% Zinfandel, 22% Carignan, 18% Petite Sirah, and the rest Mourvedre with 14.4% alcohol) offers up attractive aromas of boysenberries, black cherries, earth, pepper, and spice. Medium to full-bodied, elegant, and pure, this classy wine should drink well for 7-8 years. **91 Points Robert Parker**
