2007 Adegas O Casal Casal Novo Godello \$25.

A Godello Dry White Table wine from Valdeorras, Spain
The medium straw-colored 2007 Casal Novo Godello delivers a fragrant savory/spicy bouquet with notes of minerality, melon, and white peach. Layered and round on the palate, it is loaded with succulent white fruits, has vibrant acidity, and a lengthy, pure finish. It will drink well for several years. 91 Points Robert Parker

2007 Celler Can Blau Can Blau \$17.50

The 2007 Can Blau is purple-colored with a nose of cedar, mineral, baking spices, blueberry, and black cherry. This leads to a full-bodied wine with layers of flavor, enough structure to evolve for 2-3 years, and a pure, fruit-filled finish. It will be at its peak from 2010 to 2018.

2006 Volver Tempranillo La Mancha Spain \$16.50

The 2006 Volver is 100% Tempranillo sourced from a single vineyard planted in 1967. It was aged for 14 months in new French oak. Purple-colored, it offers up a nose of pain grille, scorched earth, spice box, and blackberry. On the palate it is quite tannic accompanied by a solid layering of spicy black fruits.

2004 Lan Rioja Reserva \$17.50

A silky texture carries expressive flavors of black plum, violet, licorice and smoke in this focused, balanced red. Has good intensity yet remains vibrant and accessible. Drink now through 2012." -Wine Spectator 90 Points Wine Spectator Top 100 Wines

2007 Adegas O Casal Casal Novo Mencia \$25.

The unoaked 2007 Casal Novo Mencia is purple-colored with an expressive perfume of cherry, black raspberry, and earth notes. This leads to a medium-bodied, smooth-textured wine with plenty of spicy red fruit flavors, excellent depth and concentration, and a finish with no hard edges. Drink this pleasure-bent wine over the next four years. 91 Points Robert Parker

2005 Mas Doix Salanges Priorat \$47.50

The 2005 Salanques, a blend of 65% Garnacha, 20% Carinena, and the balance Syrah, Merlot, and Cabernet Sauvignon, is aged in French oak for 14 months. It has a glass-coating purple-hue with an alluring bouquet of cedar, smoke, slate, blueberry, and black cherry. Youthful and structured on the palate, this potentially complex effort will profit from 5-7 years of additional cellaring.
