**2006 Cliff Creek Cabernet Franc Rogue Valley \$28.**

The nose is bright fruit flavors, layers of mineral and spice. The fruit tends toward intense layers of blue berry, pomegranate and loganberry, backed by racy minerality, vibrant acidity and understated spices (nutmeg, cardamom, a hint of vanilla). It's a medium-bodied though dense wine, balanced, with full well-integrated tannin. Winemaker Joe Dobbies

**2008 Andrew Rich Mesalliance Red Blend \$20.50**

A rich blend of 60% Merlot; 30 Cabernet Franc and 10% Syrah from the Columbia Valley. Delicious now for its softness and fruit, though it will age well for several more years.

**2006 Penner Ash Syrah Rogue Valley \$31.** Elderberry, black pepper and exotic spice. Deep, dark purple fruits expand on palate along with bittersweet chocolate and Italian plum. Refined tannins integrate into an extended savory finish. This wine spent 15 months in French oak: 9 months in 40% new French oak, 7 months in neutral French oak. Co-fermented with 2% Viognier

**2007 Griffin Creek Cabernet Sauvignon \$40.**

Well-formed Cabernet with dark and developed fruit~black cherry, plum, and juicy black berry. Peppermint patties, round tannins, and a very full mouth feel with nice tannins. A heady herbal attack followed by rousing fruit, a rich black top soil accented, and a nice sweet, silky finish. Complex dusty earth and mineral expression~crushed travertine, Approachable and distinguished. Perfect to pair with dark chocolate.
