Very pale yellow. Pungent yet subtle aromas of lemon and jalapeno pepper. Densely packed, pliant and ripe, with serious breadth to the racy, soil-driven flavors of citrus, pepper, spices and stone. This really spreads out to dust the entire mouth. Finishes aromatic and quite pure, with lovely stony length. **91 Points Stephen Tanzer**

2009 Efeste Feral Sauvignon Blanc "Evergreen Vineyard" Washington \$18.

2009 Andrew Rich "Croft Vineyard" Oregon \$20.50

2008 Provenance Sauvignon Blanc California \$19

Reminiscent of a perfectly ripe honeydew melon, with a nice fleshy texture, offering details of apricot, citrus and mango. A wonderful purity of fruit flavors really sings on the long, focused finish. Drink now through 2012. **91 Points Wine Spectator**

2008 Chateau Vacheron Sancerre Loire Valley France \$34.50

Very pale yellow. Highly aromatic bouquet of lemongrass, lime, smoky minerals and anise, plus a hint of white pepper. Dry, focused and pure, offering mineral-laced citrus and orchard fruit flavors given grip by dusty minerals. The finish is refreshingly spicy and very persistent. This will be fleshier and deeper with a year's more bottle age. **91 Points Stephen Tanzer**
