2016 Cade Estate Winery Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, CA. \$120 Deep purple-black colored, the 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley sings of black and red cherries, warm cassis and wild blueberries with suggestions of cedar chest, tapenade, lavender and dusty soil. Full, opulent and drop-dead sexy in the mouth, the palate struts layers of black fruits, floral notions and baking spices with a velvety texture and very long finish. **95 Points Wine Advocate (Owned by Pump Jack)**

2015 Abeja Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley, WA. \$54 Deeply colored, the 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon (87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Merlot, and the rest Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot) spent 18 months in 70% new French oak. It has a brilliant bouquet of crème de cassis, toasted spice, graphite, and licorice. This gives way to a full-bodied Cabernet that has ripe, velvety tannins, beautiful mid-palate depth, and a great finish. **93 Points Wine Advocate**

2016 DeLille Cellars Four Flags Cabernet Sauvignon, WA. \$50 All Red Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon, the 2016 Four Flags offers lots of ripe red and black fruits, spice, lead pencil and cedar notes, full-bodied richness, beautiful purity and a layered, rich, balanced style. This cuvée gains weight in bottle and is, year in, year out, one of the best Bordeaux blends from this estate. **93-96 Points Jeb Dunnuck**

2016 JB Neufeld Two Blonds Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon Yakima Valley, WA. \$42 Aged 22 months in 75% new French oak, the 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Two Blondes (100% Cabernet) has an attractive herbal, coffee-like character as well as loads of black fruits. It's plush and full-bodied, with a good finish. It should keep for at least 8-10 years **90 Points Jeb Dunnuck**

2014 John Anthony Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon, CA. \$80 John Anthony Vineyards has produced a beautiful 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon with notes of plum, blueberry, black raspberry and the telltale blackcurrant. The wine exhibits a gentle and judicious use of oak, medium to full body, a lush suppleness, and a deep ruby/purple color. This is impeccably made, well-balanced Cabernet Sauvignon with elegance yet authority. Drink it over the next 12-15 years. **93 Points Wine Advocate**

2015 Gramercy Columbia Valley, WA. \$50 A blend of 83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, and 2% Petit Verdot, the 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon spent 21 months in 52% new French oak. Its vivid ruby/plum color gives way to a classically constructed, concentrated effort that has beautiful depth of fruit, building tannins, and a great finish. It's going to age like a great Saint-Julien and have 15+ years of longevity. 975 cases. **93 Points Jeb Dunnuck**
