2017 Orin Swift Eight years in the Desert CA. \$50 A blend of Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Syrah and Grenache, aged eight months in 30% new French oak, the deep garnet-purple colored 2017 Red Blend 8 Years in the Desert bursts forth with blackberry pie, warm cassis, licorice and raspberry pie with touches of tree bark, garrigue and potpourri. Full-bodied, rich and jam-packed with opulent berry preserves and exotic spice layers, it has a velvety texture and wonderful freshness, finishing very long. **93 Points Wine Advocate**

2017 Orin Swift Abstract CA. \$40

The 2017 Proprietary Red Abstract is made up of Syrah, Petite Sirah, Grenache and Zinfandel, aged eight months in 30% new French and American oak. It has a deep garnet-purple color and features black cherries, fresh black berries and redcurrants with touches of mossy bark, black pepper and garrigue. Full and firm, with a wonderfully rounded texture, it offers loads of black fruit and peppery layers, finishing long and earthy. **91 Points Wine Advocate**

2014 Trefethen Dragon's Tooth Napa Valley, CA. \$40 _2014 Dragon's Tooth is a blend of 45% Malbec, 35% Petit Verdot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. This is black/purple in color with an interesting nose of charcoal, blueberry and plum. The wine tastes more like a Petite Sirah-super-intense, monolithic, but concentrated and powerful. I suspect 5-7 years of aging will reveal significantly more charm and character than it's showing right now, but this is a big, back strapping, massively rich wine.
