**2017 Mollydooker “Blue Eyed Boy”, McLaren Vale, Australia \$60**

Stylish, fragrant and supple, with dried lavender, vanilla bean and mocha notes that add richness to the core of ripe, jammy blueberry and blackberry flavors. Harmonious and creamy on the long, generous finish. Drink now through 2029. **92 Points Wine Spectator**

**2017 Mollydooker “The Maitre D’ Cabernet Sauvignon McLaren Vale, Australia \$32**

Plump and spicy, with sarsaparilla, cream soda and nutmeg accents to the core of plush, ripe raspberry preserve and cherry compote notes. Great harmony and a polished, smooth body add to the charm. Drink now through 2029. 5,342 cases made, 2,056 cases imported **92 Points Wine Spectator**

**2015 Tait “The Ball Buster” Barossa Valley 100% Basket pressed Old Vines \$17**

Pure, juicy blueberry and cherry flavors are set up against chalky tannins, which add traction to the lush fruit. Black tea and spice notes linger on the finish. Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Drink now through 2028. **90 Points Wine Spectator**

**2017 Mollydooker “The Boxer” South Australia \$32**

Robust, with notes of caramel and amaretto to the bold berry, cherry and cassis flavors. Toasty and spicy on the long finish. Drink now. 48,929 cases made, 16,030 cases imported. — **MW 88 Wine Spectator**

**2016 Pen Folds Bin 28 Australia Upper Adelaide and Wrattenbully, Australia \$33**

The full-bodied 2016 Bin 28 Kalimna Shiraz is a blend of fruit from Barossa Valley, McLaren Vale, Padthaway, Upper Adelaide and Wrattenbully. It's a warm-climate, rich, plush Shiraz, with a velvety mouthfeel and lingering savory notes on the finish. **91 Points Wine Advocate**

**2015 Tait Family Winery “The Wild Ride” Barossa Valley \$17**

Tait's 2015 The Wild Ride is a blend of 60% Shiraz, 20% Grenache and 20% Mataro. It boasts hints of vanilla and graham crackers on the nose, alongside notes of mulberries and plums. A big, full-bodied wine at 15.9% alcohol, it's nevertheless reasonably light on the palate, with just a touch of warmth on the supple finish. Drink it over the next 3-4 years. **90 Points Wine Advocate**

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
