The Wines:

2011 Henry Earl Homesteader Red Mountain Red \$42

Firm and generous, with a swarm of fine tannins around a pulsing core of black cherry, coffee and spice flavors, persisting into a long and expressive finish. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Malbec and Cabernet Franc. Best from 2018 through 2021. 250 cases made 92 Points Wine Spectator

2015 Syncline "Cuvee Elena" Columbia Valley \$45

Our southern Rhone inspired blend was selected from our most balanced and elegant barrels from the 2015 vintage. A blend of 60% Mourvedre, 20% Syrah, 13% Grenache & 7% Carignan Rich and savory, the fresh blackberry and raspberry aromas and flavors are complemented by hints of violet and black pepper, with an elegant texture and graceful, velvety finish. 2013 Hedges Family Estate, Red Mountain Red \$26

The 2013 Red Mountain Blend is drinking well, wafting from the glass with notes of sweet soil, tobacco leaf, cocoa nib and red-black fruit, framed by nicely integrated American oak. Medium-bodied, rich and savory, it reveals a bright line of acidity and chewy tannins that are crying out for food. **90 Points Wine Advocate** 59% Cabernet Sauvignon 28% Merlot 5% Cabernet Franc 4% Malbec 2% Syrah 2% Petit Verdot

2016 Intrinsic Red Blend Columbia Valley \$22 (Our new Fall glass pour)

Made from 52% Cabernet Franc, 44% Malbec, 3% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 1% Merlot, the 2016 Red Blend sports a vibrant purple color as well as terrific notes of cassis and blackberry fruits, spice box, licorice, and hints of vanilla. This medium to full-bodied effort has no hard edges, beautiful purity and finesse, and a great finish, all making it a terrific value. **90 Points Jeb Dunuck**

2017 The Jack Red Blend Walla Walla, \$20

Merlot makes up just over three-quarters of this blend, with the balance Malbec, Cabernet Franc, Sangiovese and Petit Verdot. Bright aromas of cherry pie, blueberry, herb, plum and earth are followed by smooth polished blue-fruit flavors. It's a complete delight, focusing on elegance. **89 Points Wine Enthusiast**

2016 Abbot's Table Red Blend Columbia Valley \$20

47% Sangiovese, 22% Zinfandel, 19% Blaufrankish, 12% Malbec A beautiful garnet red hue is luscious with bursting aromas of black currants, blueberry and cherry. A layer of white pepper spice and tobacco are interlaced with gripping acidity, roasted red pepper and earth notes. This bright red blend is youthful and shows great cellaring potential!
