

April 2020 Cheap & Cheerful Red Six pack \$72.90

2017 Old Soul Petite Sirah Lodi California \$12 To balance the prominent grip characteristic of Petite Sirah, this particular blend was crafted with a softer, more elegant body. This wine opens with immediate hints of blueberry and blackberry, followed by accents of Dutch chocolate and a subtle touch of cardamom. The palate is big and weighty with ample mid-palate and soft, velvety tannins.

2016 Merf Cabernet Sauvignon Washington \$15 Aromas of black currant, cedar, toast, spice, plum, green pepper and cherry lead to dense, tightly backed red and black fruit flavors. It has a lovely sense of freshness, balance, and length—a whole lot of wine for the money. **90 Points Wine Enthusiast**

2017 Carmen Gran Reserva Carmenère Chile \$15 Carmen Gran Reserva is a classic Chilean Carmenère from the El Peñasco Vineyard, Apalta in the Colchagua Valley. Dark ruby in the glass, intense cherry, sweet tobacco and dark chocolate aromas with dark cherry, sweet cake spice and dark chocolate on the plate. Delicious. Pair with a grilled prime rib. Carmenère food pairings: lamb, pasta, venison, char-grilled burgers, tamarind-marinated steaks.

2018 Delas Ventoux Red Rhone, France \$12 Delas Freres are a company based in the historic Northern Rhone and produced a range of wines from top to bottom in some of the best vineyard sites of the Rhone Valley

The Ventoux red from Delas is a lighter bodied Rhone made predominantly from Grenache with a bit of Syrah for body and structure. Soft red fruits dominate this easy drinking red. Soft tannins and an easy finish make it very drinkable on its own or with simple red and white meat dishes.

2014 Seven Fall Merlot Washington \$14 The Seven Falls Merlot is complex and layered, filled with bright cherry, blackberry, black currant and herbs. This wine is juicy and full bodied with hints of cocoa and a rich, silky mouthfeel. It has softer tannins which enhance the flavors of milder foods.

2017 Mercer Bros. Red Blend Washington \$13 This wine leads with aromas and flavors of bursting ripe, black cherry and plum with notes of milk chocolate, coffee and sweet smoke. All of this lends to a balance of plush fruit and powdery tannins in the mid-palate, ending with a long lingering -finish with notes of bing cherry and spice. 2019 Anne Amie Rose of Pinot Noir \$16 Served chilled, Oregon Rosé wines are refreshing and food friendly. Rose flavors lean toward the red berries—strawberry, cherry and raspberry. It pairs well with steak and seafood, or cheese and crackers. Enjoy Oregon Rosé anytime. I love the wine and the label looks like Easter/Spring

Blanc Pescador Mediterranean White Wine \$12 A second natural fermentation gives this dry and fruity wine a special freshness, elegance and personality. Store the bottle in an upright position at 20°C or below.

2016 Nine Hats Pinot Gris Washington \$15 This wine's red and yellow apple and melon aromas lead to broad, fleshy fruit flavors. It's direct and delivers a lot of appeal.

2018 THE SEEKER Sauvignon Blanc Sauvignon New Zealand \$10 Tangy lime, melon and candied green apple flavors are fresh and juicy on a light, refreshing frame. Drink now **88 Points Wine Spectator**

2019 Pike Road Pinot Gris Oregon \$12 We've farmed in Oregon for five generations and grown wine grapes in Oregon's Willamette Valley for over four decades. After years of producing some of Oregon's most acclaimed wines at Elk Cove Vineyards, we decided to create a new Oregon wine company focused on quality Pinot Noir under \$20. We named this wine project Pike Road after the winding road that runs adjacent to our vineyards at the foothills of Oregon's Coast Range Mountains. Pike Road is made from estate grown grapes and a smaller amount of fruit we purchase. We are committed to preserving small family farms here in the Willamette Valley through our relationships with partner growers, some of whom we have worked with for decades. This is the best place in the New World to grow Pinot Noir and Pinot Gris, and we are so pleased to be here at Pike Road.

Vega Medien Brut Cava Spain \$10 Unión Vinícola del Este produces this Vega Medien Brut Nature , a sparkling wine from Cava de Valencia that is based on macabeo and chardonnay grapes and has an alcoholic strength of 11%. Drinks & Co users evaluate this sparkling wine with 4 out of 5 points.
