Hot August Night White Cheap & Cheerful 2020 \$60.30

2018 Joseph Mellot Sinérite Sauvignon Loire Valley \$10

Pale gold color, brilliant and clear. Elegant and delicate nose of tropical and citrus fruits. Well balance of freshness & fullness. Notes of lemon and passion fruit. Expressive & aromatic finish.

2018 Domaine Duffour Cotes De Gascogne France \$11 Aromatic gooseberry and chive notes lead to flavors of grapefruit and peach in this crisp, light-bodied white, with floral and white pepper accents lingering into the finish. Lively, showing integrated acidity. Drink now through 2020.

2018 Arca Nova Branco Vinho Verde Portugal \$10

Clarity: Absolutely clean, no sediment. There is some spritz to this. Hue: Pale straw with a light gold rim Nose: green apples is the dominant with notes of honey and white pear Body: Light(+) Palate: soft minerals with a nice tartness of the green apples and nice balance of the acidity. Acidity: Medium(+) Finish: nice crisp medium finish, with still that green apple and some lemon zest, making me drool at the mouth. Love it! Bonus Screw Cap!

2019 Mas La Chevaliere Chardonnay France \$13 Strong citrusy aromas on the nose, with yellow-fruit richness **Taste:** Bright flavors of ripe fruit; good balance and aromatic finish

· **Aging:** 6 months in stainless-steel tanks, no barrel aging

· **Filtration:** Minimum filtration to preserve maximum natural character of the wine; then bottled under low pressure on a bottling line designed to protect quality.

2018 Cantine Colosi Bianco Terre Sicillane IGP Italy \$11

Izolia, Cattaratto, Grillo...Pale, straw yellow with green hints. Nose of flowers and vibrant fruit. Round and generous fruit and excellent length. Refreshing easy to get into with a lovely screw top!

2019 Pike Road Pinot Gris Oregon \$12 After a warm May and a healthy, early fruit-set, the summer ended cool with no threat of the sunburn or hazy, smoky skies seen in recent years. We expected to pick in early September, but weeks of unseasonably cool weather took us by surprise. Rather than rushing to pick too early, we waited patiently for concentrations and sugar levels to rise. Expect wines with a big ripe core of concentrated fruit and a bright, fresh profile.

Santiam Wine & Bistro' August ROSE Six-Pick \$84.60

Make it a dozen Rosè if you wish! THINK PINK {

2017 Ca Maiol Chiaretto Rose Lombardi, Italy \$13

The Garda Chiaretto is prized for its fragrance and its delicate perfume. Aromas of strawberry and delicate spring flowers, elegant mouthfeel, and flavors of white almonds and red berry fruits.
Food Pairings: Freshwater fish, poultry, or mushroom-based dishes. Perfect with pizza.

2019 King Estate Rose Southern Oregon \$16

The elegance of this estate-grown rosé is juxtaposed with its remarkable, vibrant rose petal hue. This rosé is light, bright, and playful from start to finish, with a nose comprised of key lime notes, accompanied by hibiscus and strawberry elements. Red fruit and floral notes highlight the approachable complexity of this wine, as black cherry, strawberry, rose water and lime zest components dance on the palate. A respectable acidity adds backbone to this rosé, leading to a clean finish with generous length. Enjoy now until at least 2026.

2018 Whispering Angel Rose \$21

Whispering Angel is a very good effort from this export-focused winery. A blend of Grenache, Cinsault, Vermentino, and Tibouren, it offers peach and melon aromas along with a plump, medium-bodied palate and a crisp, grapefruit-y finish.

2019 Milbrandt Rose Washington \$14

A lovely, pale salmon color in the glass leads to enticing aromas of cherry blossom and orange zest. The mouthfeel is crisp and dry with flavors of strawberry, watermelon rind, pink peppercorns and rosemary. Finishes lush but dry and totally refreshing.

2019 Stoller Family Estate Rose Oregon \$15 Sourced exclusively from our Corral Creek Vineyard, our 2019 Rosé of Pinot Noir was intentionally grown using the internationally renowned Scott Henry trellising system – named after the Oregon wine pioneer from Southern Oregon. The nose is clean and bright, with notes of strawberry, rose petal, and grapefruit. The palate is fresh and long, with a compelling tension created by aging the wine in a concrete tank and a small amount of oak. There is a hint of viscosity that provides a nice roundness on the palate with a juicy finish.

2019 Routas Provence Rose \$15 45% Cinsault 35% Grenache, 20% Syrah James Suckling 91 "Another beautiful bottle of rose with slice-apple, peach and light stone character. It's medium-to-full-bodied with pretty fruit and a bright finish. Lots of flint and stone undertones to the fruit" " This may be the best value rosé in the world"

August Red Cheap & Cheerful \$68.40

2017 Pendulum Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley, WA \$15 Svelte and precise, with expressive black cherry, espresso and dusty spice flavors that end with fine-grained tannins. Drink now through 2026 Enjoy with anything on the BBQ **90 Points Wine Spectator**

2018 Root 1 Carmenere Chile \$11 Intense violet in color with ripe aromas of blackberries and warm spice. Full-bodied and fruit-forward with plum, cherry and a hint of smoke. Smooth tannins and good structure create perfect balance and a powerful finish with notes of vanilla. The supple tannins lend itself to pairings like barbecued brisket and thick-cut bacon, but equally as good matched with a full spread of Spanish tapas or stuffed peppers.

Marietta Old Vine #70 CA \$15 Marietta's bottlings are consistently high in quality, medium in body, and nicely balanced. This blend of Zinfandel and red Rhône grapes is no exception, showing spicy, dark, gorgeous fruit. BBQ Wine...think Ribs!

2019 El Supremo Malbec Argentina \$9 Deep dark red, with violet-like tints. Bouquet: It has a complex aroma of red fruits, such as plums, cherries and raspberries, with a hint of violets. Palate: Concentrated, with a long and velvety finish. A fruit-forward wine with dark red fruit flavors. Sweet tannins. AGING POTENTIAL 2 to 3 year. What a deal! Pair with grilled Flank Steak Great BBQ wine for the hot summer nights!

2018 Chateau Malbat Bordeaux France \$12 80% Merlot 20% Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes This wine's ruby color still reflects the purple hues of its youth. Red leaks and wood fruits make up the freshness of its bouquet. On the palate, the attack is frank and fruity on notes of cherry typical of Merlot, to give way to tannins melted in length.

2015 Seven Falls Merlot WA \$14 Vanilla aromas are at the fore, along with notes of nougat, sweet spice and cherry. Rich, barrel-forward flavors follow, with the tannins.
