## Featured wines for April Fools:

The Pink Bitch Bubbly and Bitch Red are back! Fun April Fools present! \$11

**NV Skylite Cellars "Big Red Hiney" Walla Walla \$12.50**

73% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, & 5% Syrah

This is just a fun wine with a fun name. It is a pitch black colored wine that opens with a very attractive and fruity blackberry jam bouquet with a hint of oak. On the palate, this wine is full bodied, fruit forward and jammy. The flavor profile is a tasty blackberry jam with notes of strawberry, smoky oak and a hint of blueberry and black pepper. The finish is dry and its smoky flavors linger slightly. This fun red blend would pair well with the first grilled Cheese Burger of the season! So as the motto on the bottle says, "You go around once in life, so grab all the Hiney wine you can get." Catchy name and so is the wine. **No fooling around**

### **Favorite Pinot's:**

**2008 Pudding River Estate Willamette Valley Pinot Noir \$18 We are serving this by the glass at Santiam Wine Co. & Bar**

With an initial aroma of earth and spice leading to a dark and rich black fruit mid-palate this wine is very representative of the 2008 vintage. It is fullbodied with a refreshing acidity that leads to a finish of firm tannins.

**2009 Stoller Dundee Hills Pinot Noir JV W.V. \$26.**

The two Pinot offerings begin with the 2009 Pinot Noir JV (Junior Vines), a cuvee of the estate's younger vines. It sports an alluring bouquet of smoke, spice box, rose petal, and red fruits. Nicely balanced but in need of slightly more depth and concentration, it will provide pleasure over the next 5-6 years.

#### **2009 Revelry Cabernet Sauvignon, WA. \$12**

Deep red fruit and defined structure. Nice balance through the lingering finish. Enjoy this wine over the next few years. You should try it now while it is available. You may want to stock-up on this gem!

#### **2011 Colonia Las Liebres Bonarda Spain \$12**

You just want to hop, skip, and jump away with this tasty wine! Bright, full ruby-red. Aromas of blackberry, violet, chocolate and menthol. Firm blackberry, licorice and floral flavors are nicely framed by harmonious acidity and complicated by a saline element. This nice sappy, persistent bonarda displays tannins that are suave and fine for the variety.

#### **2009 Chateau Baby Bordeaux, France \$10**

Merlot from its birthplace - Bordeaux. Berry and dried-cherry fruit with decent structure, a bit of dust and stem, no jam, no oak blasts or otherwise heavy-handed winemaking going on...and the cutest name ever...all for \$10! Sweet Baby Jesus! An excellent and affordable wine for the holiday feasts that are upon us. Discounts extended for case (10%)

#### **2009 Camino de Navaherreros, Madrid: \$14**

The 2009 Camino de Navaherreros is 100% Garnacha sourced from 80+-year-old vines aged in large wooden upright vats. It surrenders delicate red cherry aromas along with hints of cinnamon and incense. Buttressed by uplifting acidity on the palate, this is an intense, impeccably balanced wine that delivers plenty of bang for the buck. Drink it over the next 3 years. **90 Points Robert Parker**

#### **2009 La Villa Chianti Colli Senesi Italy \$10**

The DOCG Chianti Colli Senesi produced by "La Torre" farm is a robust, ruby-red colored wine, with a traditional, full-bodied aroma. It is perfect served with red and white meats, cold cuts, prosciutto and traditional Tuscan dishes. It is made with Sangiovese and Canaiolo grapes and is the Tuscan wine par excellence. It takes its name from the region of the same name, which features a unique and singular atmosphere in the hills of Tuscany.

#### **2010 Vina Borgia Garnacha Borja, Spain \$7**

The 2010 Vina Borgia is 100% Garnacha fermented and aged in stainless steel. Notes of cinnamon, clove, violets, and black cherry lead to an easy going, smooth-textured red that finishes with no hard edges. Drink this friendly offering over the next 3 years. **86 Points Robert Parker**
