Cremant de Loire Brut Rose, Baumard \$25

Composed entirely of cabernet franc -- which is unusual -- the Baumard Rose Brut Extra delivers an utterly dry, restrained fruitiness with notes of red currants. The delicate pale salmon hue is textbook-perfect. Beautifully packaged in a clear bottle with a matte finish and silver label that simply says "Rose Brut Extra Baumard," it's uncommonly elegant-looking. Enjoy with your holiday meal.

2007 Brick House Cuvee Ribbon Ridge, OR \$25

"It is a blend of Dijon and Pommard clones from various blocks of the estate and it has amazing aromas and flavors of sweet, dark cherries, dark plums and a touch of spice that reminded me of white pepper. Very elegant stuff but it

2003 Martin Ray Merlot, Napa Valley: \$11.50

Dare to drink Merlot! This wine has complex aromas of raspberry, blackberry and Carob mixed with cedar spice. Aged to perfection and usually sales for \$20. Enjoy the smooth and silky in texture. This is a great bargain and a special treat **only Santiam Wine customers** are going to enjoy!

2006 Bodegas Arzuaga "La Planta" Tempranillo, Ribera Di Duero, Spain: \$14

A deep ruby red, this Ribera del Duero has bright aromas of red berry, spice and bacon. The palate has loads of raspberry and cherry with pleasant tannins and balanced oak. Though medium bodied, this is a wonderfully flavorful wine.

2006 Water Brook Melange, WA: \$13

Aromas of cedar, spice and dark stone fruit are a warm welcome. Black cherry and plum notes marry with delicious flavors of dark chocolate and toasted oak. Balanced tannins and lingering fruit round out the finish.

2007 Domaine Rouge-Blue Vin de Pays: \$14

From the French Mediterranean this lovely wine shines with tons of interesting smooth flavors. Made from 35 year old Grenache and 55 year old Carignan. A steal for under \$15. This will match up well with your red meat dishes.

2006 Durigutti Malbec Mendoza, Argentina: \$13

Purple in color, with oaky aromas manifested in the form of sawdust, cinnamon and chocolate. Ripe berry and plum notes carry the toasty palate, and the finish comes back with additional chocolate, toast and vanilla. Rich and solid. YUM!

2005 Lafage Cote Sud, Southern France: \$13

Syrach-based (10% each Grenache and Cabernet). Intense aromas of plum paste, cherry, iodine and herbs lead into a richly-fruited, deeply mineral, dynamic palate with layering and interplay of black chocolate, lavender, licorice, cherry preserves, singed meat, salts and iodine. A wine this rich and complex, and with a finish this long, takes on an aura of unreality when one sees the price! This wine can age for several years. Enjoy with a hardy stew! Comfort food for comfort wine!
