2007 Ca' Del Baio Barbera d' Alba Paolina, Italy: \$14

This wine was a little more than I would want to put in the Cheap & Cheerful Six-Pack. But, it is a wine that I would like you to try because it is awesome! A great gift for dad! Take home a six pack of these and save 10%.

A fresh, pleasant wine sustained by a vein of acidity and tamed by a judicious period in large oak casks.

2006 Vista Hills Treehouse Willamette Valley Pinot Noir, Oregon: \$27.50

This estate-grown '06 Treehouse shows intense ripe and forward flavors, along with bright and expansive aromatics. Rich color and

firm structure provide complex mouthfeel and texture. The 2006 was produced for Vista Hills at Northwest Wine Company by Laurent Montalieu. Vista Hill's donates 10% of all sales to the Clinton Foundation for College Students!

2007 Celler Can Blau "Can Blau", Montsant, Spain: \$17.50

The 2007 Can Blau is purple-colored with a nose of cedar, mineral, baking spices, blueberry and black cherry. This leads to a full-bodied wine with layers of flavor, enough structure to evolve for 2-3 years, and a pure, fruit-filled finish. It will be at its peak from 2010-2018. (90+, Robert Parker)

2008 Castle Rock Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley: \$13

e the first one on the block to enjoy a 2008 Oregon Pinot Noir for only \$13. Can this be true? Yes, indeed sweet oak, and floral notes, with a long velvety finish. This versatile wine pairs well with lamb, chicken, veal, salmon and light pasta dishes. This wine offers a lot of bang for the buck!

2007 Domaine du Trapadis Côtes Du Rhone, France: \$11.50

his wine is organically farmed and horse plowed. The grape is 100% Grenache. They used a natural yeast fermentation. The wine is oak free with bright fruit forward flavors. The right wine to pair with chicken, pasta and cheeses. Another excellent wine from the 2007 vintage.

2007 Tenuta Sant' Antonio SCAIA Rossa, Italy: \$11

uby red with hints of red rose and violet, fruity with notes of red and black cherry, plum, wood fruits like well-balanced pungency and freshness. Intense with good body despite its graceful youth. The grape is Corvina.

2007 Corvidae The Rook, Oregon: \$12.50

nother super value from our friends at Owen Roe Winery! The Rook is another wine in the Raven collection. A blend a terrific value! Flavors of berries, cinnamon, black cherries, of 77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Syrah and 8% Merlot. A big juicy rich blend. Dark berries and a touch of cassis on the nose. The finish is a velvet glove. Enjoy these wines while they are still around and look for them again in the next vintage!

2008 Colores Del Sol Malbec, Argentina: \$10

eaning "colors of the sun" this Malbec is sourced from some of the highest vineyards in Mendoza, South America's most prestigious wine growing region. This Malbec is absolutely stunning in the glass with its deep dark garnet color, followed by enormous aromas of cherries, blackberry, currant and tea, with a finish of smoke, spice and caramel. Full bodied with ample tannins.

2006 Vaca Reserve Cabernet Rio Vaca Vineyards, CA. \$13

ocated 10 miles east of the Napa Valley. The property's 25year-old vines were planted in ancient volcanic and alluvial blackberry, red and black currant, raspberry. The flavors are soils, which yields fruit with complex and concentrated flavors. This cab is blended with small amounts of syrah, producing a dark wine, with ripe velvety tannins.
