2007 Chappellet Mountain Cuvee Napa Valley \$28. "Chappellet winery always seems to over-deliver on quality for the price, thanks in large part to the estate's 100 acres of vines on Pritchard Hill, high above Napa Valley. The 2007 is a blend of 51 percent Cabernet Sauvignon and 46 percent Merlot, with a dash of Malbec, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. The wine is rich and seamlessly mouthfilling yet complex and beautifully structured. It's ready to drink in the short term - it brought out the best in the beef - but will do fine in the cellar for a few years. I rated it 92 points, non-blind. It sells for \$29, a bargain by most Napa standards. Winemaker Notes - This is the wine to choose when you're looking for vivid, mouth-filling fruit flavors. Our Mountain Cuvee is a winemaker's blend that beautifully

expresses the distinctive qualities of the traditional Bordeaux varietals, and is crafted for early consumption. Each component making up the cuvee contributes nuances that mingle with and complement each other. The result is a complex array of aromas and flavors that deliver pure pleasure in a glass." **92 Points Tim Fish Wine Spectator**

2009 Chiaretto Rosé Provenza, Italy: \$13

Known as the "one night wine" since after pressing, the juice of the grapes are left to ferment with the skins for just a single night. Chiaretto is distinguished by its soft strawberry color and delicate structure. It has an elegant, refreshing flavor with strawberries and spring flowers on the nose. Always the favorite around here! **STOCK-UP~ HERE COMES THE SUNSHINE!**

2007 M. David Wind Mill Old Vine Zinfandel, CA: \$12.

This zin is heady with the aromas of ripe, soft, brambly blackberries, Bing cherries and vanilla, leading to a full-mouth feel with rich chewy tannins and hints of dark chocolate. Enjoy this wine with those baby back ribs! Drink now

2007 Irony Cabernet Sauvignon California: \$13.

This Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon offers layers of flavor, reflecting its varied terroir. Aromatic violets, tobacco, cocoa and bright red berry character leads into rich, concentrated fruit flavors of raspberries, currants and succulent black cherries. The ripe fruit flavor is juxtaposed with natural acidity for a balanced, well-structured wine with medium tannins and a supple finish drink now-2015

2008 Visa Alba Corte C Malbec, Argentina: 10.75

Expressive aromas of dark berry fruits, with enticing notes of pepper, leather, smoke and chocolate. Rich and ripe, spicy and full of sweet redcurrants and blackcurrants, cherry, licorice and pepper, with hints of tobacco and violets. Excellent! Great for the BBQ too! Drink now -2013

2008 Domaine Chistia Côtes du Rhône, France: \$13.

Beautiful bright garnet red. Intense nose showing good complexity. Aromas of black fruits and wild herbs prevail. Good attack on the palate. A fine wine which is elegant and well structured. Nice volume and length based on fruity and spicy aromas. Enjoy with Lamb, Ripe Cheeses, liver paté. Drink now through 2014

2009 Alberti 154 Malbec Argentina: \$12.

Tons of dark berry fruit on the front, some boysenberry to vanilla sweet mid leather notes and chewy. Sustained finish with a little coffee and even tobacco and liquorice right at the end. Drink now-2013

2007 Vidal-Fleury Côtes du Rhône, France: \$10.

Bright ripe cherry aromas. Classic flavors, fresh, clean and bright. Easy drinking, refreshing. I enjoyed this wine from nose to finish -- it's just a clean, well produced wine that would be great for every day drinking. Nice cozy finish. Enjoy with many cuisine drink now-2012
