2008 Lemelson Six Vineyards Willamette Valley Pinot Noir: \$17.50

Six Vineyards is often a great deal but this wine is the runaway steal of the vintage. The 2008 Six Vineyards has great aromatic complexity with citrus zest, flowers, rainier cherries and Asian spice. The palate is bright and fresh with lovely, sweet red cherry and citrus throughout the mid-palate. The finish is a bit shorter than our other wines but this wine is so lovely and easy to drink, we're not sure you'll notice.

2007 Talbott Logan Chardonnay, CA: \$18

This 2007 vintage of Logan displays the

appealing qualities that have come to define this wine. The color is medium-straw with great clarity. In the bouquet, aromas of kiwi and guava mingle with notes of vanilla and toast. On the palate, the wine displays a rich mouthfeel, excellent structure and good balance. The initial impression offers lush tropical fruit followed by a citrus and mineral mid-palate and a long, satisfying brioche finish.

2009 Charles & Charles Red Wine, Columbia Valley: \$11

“A blend of cabernet sauvignon (51%) and syrah (49%). It's a young wine, but it's already shockingly luscious with chewy dark fruit that is hard not to love. I think the most notable difference between the vintages is that with the 07, the cab sauv dominated the personality of the wine with the syrah playing a minor role. But with the 09 it's a much gutsier syrah that takes far more control of the agenda, and we're psyched about that”. The Winery

2009 Immortal Zinfandel Lodi Appellation, California: \$11

Velvety layered mix of red cherry, strawberry, cocoa and juicy red fruit followed by light toast and smooth, chiseled tannins leading to a lengthy, almost breathless finish. This wine is to be enjoyed with BBQ ribs and fun times!

2007 Vale Do Bomfim Tinta Barroca, Portugal: \$10

Tinta Barroca (58%). It also blends in Tinta Roriz (15%), Touriga Nacional (14%), Tinta Amarela (5%) and Tinto Cao (8%). This bottling has always been a good source for easy drinking value, and it is again this year. Fruity but bright, tasty but elegant, with some dark chocolate notes, this has little mid-palate concentration, tons of charm and just a little grip on the finish. Drink now.

2009 Legado Muñoz Tempranillo, Castilla, Spain: \$10

Aromas of cherry and plum, with hints of espresso and bitter chocolate. Juicy and exuberant, with a bracing acid streak perking up the red and black fruit flavors. Vibrant, fresh and brisk through the finish, with the cherry flavor remaining focused and bright.

2009 Cellar Els Guiamets Mas dels Mets Montsant, Spain: \$7 (33% Grenache, 33% Mazuela & 34% Tempranillo)

Deep, bright red. Primary raspberry and blackberry aromas are complemented by notes of iron and rose. Juicy, slightly jammy red berry flavors show no obvious tannins and offer good straightforward appeal. Not especially complicated but attractively fruity. Finishes with good clarity and persistence. (88 points - Stephen Tanzer... Outstanding Value!)

2007 Ajello Nero D' Avola, Sicily, Italy: \$10.50

The 2007 Nero d'Avola is a bright, focused offering laced with perfumed red fruits, mint and spices. This is an incredibly delicious and pleasing wine, especially for the money. Drink now
