2015 Domine Bunan MAS de la ROUVIERE BANDOL ROSE France \$24 Love, love, love this wine! By the glass here.

Mourvèdre, Cinsault, Grenache. Direct pressing of whole crushed grapes. Harvested from September to mid- October.

Fermentation lasting from 11 to 17 days in stainless steel vats.

Blended in late January, and bottled in May before maturing in air-conditioned cellars. Light rosy salmon-pink hue. Fine distinct nose characterised by aromas of exotic fruits. Lasting flavour, full bodied and racy. To be drunk between 2 and 5 years. Served at

12 to 14°C. Can be associated with foie gras, traditional or slightly spiced Provencal dishes, shellfish, smoked salmon and goats cheese.

2013 Santa Ema Merlot Chile \$11

This lush and spicy red offers concentrated flavors of dark cherry, plum and dried raspberry that are creamy and rich-tasting. Milk chocolate and loads of Asian spice details fill in on the finish, revealing some savory touches. Drink now through 2019 **90 Points Wine Spectator A big favorite at our taste of Chile in August.**

2014 Gnarly Head 1924 Double Black Red Blend CA \$10

Gnarly Head 1924 Double Black delivers rich aromas of blackberry preserves, cocoa, raspberry and caramel, setting the stage for a juicy core of concentrated, dense blackberry and fig jam flavors that finish with a hint of baking spice. Jet black in the glass, pair this full-bodied wine with equally bold dishes such as charbroiled bacon cheeseburgers, spicy sausage gumbo or pork baby back ribs slathered in BBQ sauce. This wine is dark in color, with just a thin red rim. It smells of ripe blackberries, grilled beef and clove, with flavors as dense as the color. For all its color and flavor intensity and fine-grained tannins, however, it feels smooth and velvety on the tongue and is hard to resist, especially at such a reasonable price. 2014 Perazzetta Sangiovese Tuscany \$11

Alessandro Bocci, owner and winemaker at Perazzetta, is, in our opinion, making some of the best everyday wines in all of Toscana right now. Located in the D.O.C. region of Montecucco, just south of Montalcino, his wines have tremendous power, tension, and assertive terroir. Bright, stinging cherry, crisp acidity, and tantalizing earth tones make this pretty, yet interesting wine hard to resist. The everyday wine of the estate, "Sara," is named after Alessandro's

daughter, and is a tremendous follow-up to his wildly popular Rita.

2014 Seven Falls Cellars "Rapids Red" "Wahluke Slope WA \$14.50 Blend:68% Syrah, 23% Merlot, 9% Cinsault

This is a beautiful blend that shows boldness and depth but at the same time restraint and finesse. A mix of both dark fruit and softer red fruit. Hints of dried fruit and anise. This blend is mouth-coating with a spicy, smooth, elegant finish. You're going to love this!

2012 Castano Hécula Monastrell Spain \$13

The basic offering from proprietor Ramon Castano Santa, who owns a whopping 1,000 acres in Yecla, is the 2012 Hecula, which is sourced from a non-irrigated, single vineyard planted with 100% Monastrell. Aged in both tank and French oak, it comes from 60-80-year-old vines planted in limestone soils at a relatively high elevation of over 1,600 feet. Its opaque purple color is followed by copious aromas of blueberries, black raspberries, camphor, licorice, white flowers and a chalky limestone/dusty character. Full-bodied, rich and well-balanced, it is an incredible value.
