2014 Francois Gay Chorey-les-Beaune France \$29

Juicy red and blue fruits dance with crushed flower petals, baking spices, forest floor, and crushed rocks in this beguiling, characterful '14 Chorey-Les-Beaune. Fresh acidity balances with chewy tannins in this medium-bodied, delicious wine. Coming from a tiny village located near Aoxe-Corton, Ladoix and Pernand-Verglesses, Gay's 2014 Chorey-Les-Beaune offers a touch of greatness at a very affordable price; there's plenty of beautiful, old-vine fruit in this wine. A gorgeous, hard-to-find Burgundy, this Chorey-Les-Beaune drinks more like a top Beaune premier cru.
