Coelho Winery is a small family owned winery located the heart of the Willamette Valley. From their website:

"We specialize in estate grown Pinot Noir and Pinot Gris. We are also a Portuguese Family and that means we do whatever it takes (including bring Iberian varietals up from California each harvest) to make our premium port-style Portuguese varietal wines.

Our vineyard is located 3 1/2 miles from the winery on gentle rolling southern slopes and receives warm sunlight during the day making it an ideal location for producing our award winning Pinot Noir."

Here are the wines:

2007 Coelho Estate Pinot Gris \$18

Bottled from Coelho Estate fruit, this is a refreshingly dry wine with an appealing floral and citrus nose. The predominate flavor of pear leads to a hint of Meyers lemon and slightly herbaceous note. This lovely wine has a creamy feel on the palate and flows smoothly to a tartly acidic finish.

2007 Coelho Estate Chardonnay \$20

Fresh and vibrant, stylishly dry, this wine offers the appealing and balanced flavors of ripe pear, grilled pineapple and tropical fruit with a dash of ginger. Subtle oak lends to its' creamy texture and delicate note of caramel. It finishes clean with a crisp streak of cool climate acidity. A soul mate to seafood and pork dishes.

2006 Coelho Estate Pinot Noir \$35.

2006 was a standout year, and our third release of Pacincia promises an exceptional wine. This year produced a beautifully supple vintage, fragrant and expressive with fruit, toast, and spice and tawny plum in color. Leading the palate are blended notes of raspberry, blackberry, dark stone fruits, cloves and the zing of fine tannins. It finished with finesse, and the full array of flavors discovered. Savor this sophisticated classic.
