2022 Cana's FEAST Two Rivers Oregon \$16 Deep layers of black cherry, plum, and cassis meet notes of graphite, cedar, and tobacco. The palate is full-bodied and firmly structured with well-integrated tannins, vibrant acidity, and a lingering finish marked by dark chocolate and baking spice. A commanding yet polished wine. Origin: Columbia Valley, Washington, 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot. Alcohol: 14.4% Full-bodied, structured and savory, Bordeaux-style blend

2023 La Solitude Cotes du Rhone, France \$16 The 2023 Famille Lançon La Solitude Côtes du Rhône Rouge is a vibrant and expressive red wine that embodies the rich heritage of the Southern Rhône Valley. Crafted from a blend of 50% Grenache, 40% Syrah, and 10% Mourvèdre, this wine highlights the classic varietals of the region. On the nose, it offers enticing aromas of concentrated, ripe red berry fruits, complemented by subtle notes of black pepper and spice. The palate is supple and rounded, supported by a delicate tannic structure that adds depth and complexity. The finish is opulent and charming, leaving an impression.

2023 Llama Malbec Argentina \$16 From vines planted in 1918! A flavorful and chewy malbec with aromas of olives, black fruit, mocha, and tobacco. Full-bodied with excellent flavor concentration. – 91 Points JamesSuckling.co

2019 Coste di Moro Montepulciano d'abruzzo, Italy \$20 Impenetrable ruby red, red fruit on the nose and black cherry jam on everything, light notes of cocoa and toasts complete the bouquet. In the mouth it is warm, rightly tannic, and therefore soft, intense, and with the typical almond finish. Pairs with cured meat, grilled and baked meat, pasta dishes with very structured sauces. 100% Montepulciano

2022 Abbot's Table Red Blend Columbia Valley \$21 This wine honors the most fundamental form of hospitality throughout the ages; fellowship with guests over food and wine. With its unique varietal diversity, it lends itself to pair perfectly with different dishes. Bursting with notes of dark red fruit and baking spices, this wine is well balanced with a long lingering finish. Drinking now or cellar — just make sure to enjoy with company. Pretty violet aromas and a subtle nuance of tobacco leaf compliment the juicy flavors. This is an everyday red wine, able to excel at the weekend barbecue with friends or help you relax on Monday night after the first day back at work. 2024 Burgans Albarino Spain \$19 12%vol Vegan Burgans Albarino: Burgans Albarino comes from Spain's Rias Baixas region, known for its crisp and aromatic Albarino wines. This white wine offers flavors of green apple, citrus, and a hint of salinity, making it an excellent companion for seafood, especially shellfish. Twist Cap

2024 Chateau Haut-Rian White Bordeaux, France \$12 13%vol This delightful dry white wine is meant to be drunk young, cool and fresh. It delivers striking scents of lime and lemon rind, whiffs of honeydew and even a hint of seashells. And no taste of oak to be found, just 'pure play' dry white. If there's a better dry white wine for the (little) money, I haven't tasted it. I've tasted a good many dry whites at twice this price that aren't even half as good. This wine could easily become your 'house white' - it's that good." Twist Cap

2024 RAZA Vinho Verde Portugal \$13 11.5%vol Arinto (50 percent) and azal (35 percent) are two grapes that perform well in the Basto district of inland Vinho Verde. Blended here with trajadura, the combination is refreshing and green-apple bright, with juicy green-pear flavors lasting in the finish. The plentiful acidity and clean depth of fruit will take on pork with clams. Best Buy Twist Cap

2023 Archetype A Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand \$12 12% by vol Gentle notes of white peach, passion fruit and lime lead, with soft dried herbs behind. It's lightweight and delicate with well-integrated acidity, a silky texture and mouthwatering fruitiness to the finish. Twist cap

2024 Cote Mas Sauvignon Vermentino Sud de France \$16 12.5%vol Vibrant notes of citrus, grapefruit, and a touch of tropical fruits. Refreshing, with well-balanced acidity. Pairs well with chicken, fish, and curry, but also great on its own. One Liter bottle Twist Cap

2023 Terlato Estate Bottled Pinot Grigio, Italy \$17 13%vol The 2023 Pinot Grigio is a total pleasure on the nose, blending crushed almonds with white flowers, wet stone, and freshly sliced nectarines. It is soft and round with a stimulating core of acidity to balance. A sour lime tinge nicely offsets ripe orchard fruits. 2023 leaves a mineral note lingering, finishing crisp, refreshing and with medium length. -VM Vinous 90
